^aThe primary analysis required continuous health insurance enrollment for 365 days following a positive mt-sDNA result to ensure complete ascertainment of follow-up colonoscopy claims. The sensitivity analysis included all positive mt-sDNA tests regardless of post-result enrollment status and evaluated observed follow-up colonoscopy claims within 365 days after the positive test result.
